

Center High School Tardy Policy

Beginning January 4, 2012, progressive discipline will be utilized for students with excessive tardies. The policy is particular to each class period. Tardies are counted in each period as opposed to accumulated throughout the day. Here is a handy reminder of how the new policy works:

Tardy 1- no disciplinary action

Tardy 2- no disciplinary action

Tardy 3- no disciplinary action

Tardy 4- **after school detention** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 5- **after school detention** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 6- **after school detention** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 7- **full day in-house suspension** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 8- **full day in-house suspension** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 9- **full day in-house suspension** assigned for the day following the tardy

Tardy 10 or more- **at home suspension** assigned for the day following the tardy

Detention will run from 2:45 PM to 3:30 PM and will be held in Shop #2. Students arriving to detention after 2:45 PM will not be admitted and will be subject to further progressive discipline up to and including suspension at home.

Detention takes priority over all other school activities including clubs and athletic practices and games. If a "family emergency" occurs which prevents a student from attending detention on the day assigned, the parent/guardian needs to contact the appropriate administrator, Ms. Hays (338-6426) for grades 9 and 12, Mr. Jackson (338-6438) for grades 10 and 11 to schedule the next available detention date.

Detentions missed for invalid reasons will be subject to progressive discipline up to and including suspension at home.
